REGIONAL DIRECTOR'S REPORT



The Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) Regional Centre Mumbai was established in January 2009, which is bifurcated from Pune region of Maharashtra. The purpose of a separate Regional Centre in Mumbai is to cater the higher education needs of Mumbai, Mumbai suburban, Thane, Palghar, Raighad and Ratnagiri districts of Maharastra and to provide better student support services to the growing enrolment in Konkan region. Two significant aspects of IGNOU RC Mumbai are it includes grater Mumbai and Mumbai suburban where the population density is high. It covers about 25% of Maharashtra state total population in a limited land area of 30865 sq. km.

The gross enrollment (Fresh and Re-registrations) of Regional Centre Mumbai has increased from 8647 in 2010 to12222 in 2022. The Regional Centre Mumbai has achieved 40.3% of enrollment growth during 2010-2021 and 19.43% of growth during 2018-2022. A total of 12222 learners have registered with IGNOU RC Mumbai in the year 2022(of which 7409 are fresh learners and 4813 are re-registered learners)for different programmes at different academic programme level i.e certificate, diploma, bachelors and Master degree programmes

It is interesting to note that the share of fresh and young students in the total enrollment has been increasing significantly. The admission trends clearly indicates that the growing demand especially among the youth towards Open and Distance Learning (ODL). The disadvantaged sections SC, ST and OBC enrollment share in the total enrollment has also been increased due to the University policies i.e. fee exemption for SC/ST students in selected programmes.

The increasing trends of admissions have increased the responsibility of the Regional Centre to provide better student support services. Accordingly the Regional Centre is taking utmost care and measures for providing better student support services and working towards zero student grievances. Even in the COVID 19 pandemic time also the IGNOU has taken measures across the country not to disrupt the student support services. As per the directions and instructions of our Hon'ble Vice Chancellor all the IGNOU Regional Centres have initiated the online activities and support services through

online. As a part of it Regional Centre Mumbai has initiated the following online support services during COVID 19 pandemic time for prospective learners of IGNOU and learners of IGNOU Regional Centre Mumbai

The Regional Centre has initiated following online support services as pre admission support services to the prospective learners for taking admissions in IGNOU

- a) Continuous posting updated fresh admission related information on Regional Centre website and social media i.e Face Book, Twitter, YouTube and Telegram Channel. For more visibility of Fresh admission details to prospective learners a poster has created and posted on home page of Regional Centre website
- b) **Preparation of Tutorial Video for Fresh Admission:** Regional Centre Mumbai prepared a tutorial video on 'How to take fresh admission' with demo and posted it on YouTube page of the Regional Centre Mumbai. The same is available in English, Hindi and Marathi languages at RC Mumbai YouTube channel
- c) Organising online alumni meetings and disseminating admission information and other university updates: Dissemination of information among the needy people is very important for popularizing and promoting any academic programmes/activities. IGNOU has always emphasized that our Alumni is our Brand Ambassadors, accordingly good number of online alumni meetings were organized to promote IGNOU in the masses.
- d) **Preparation of Programme Specific Videos: P**repared short videos on different programmes and the same has uploaded in our YouTube channel for the benefit of prospective learners
- e) **Posting programme wise poster in FB:** The programme specific posters were prepared by the Regional Centre Mumbai and all were posted from time to time in Face book page extensively. About 50 posters of different programmes have been prepared and posted in Face book and twitter page of Regional Centre. These posters are having content of programme details, fees and support services, which is useful for the prospective learners
- f) **Online Admission Facilitating Day:** Regional Centre Mumbai made every Wednesday @ 03:00 PM as online Admission Facilitating Day through Google Meet wherein any prospective learner who had any query related to Fresh Admission could join this session and gets his/ her query sorted.

- g) **Regular online meetings with Prospective learners:** The Regional Centre was in regular touch with the applicants who had registered in online portal however not completed their application. The information was being sent through email and SMS and meetings with such learners were also conducted to sort out the queries.
- h) A Google form titled as "IGNOU ODL Admission Discussion Forum" created and sent to all the current active learners of RC Mumbai to circulate the same among their colleagues, family, friend etc. The prospective learners register through this form was contacted by the RC staff through phones within 24 hours and provided required information about IGNOU admissions.
- i) Online Meetings with Study Centres: The Regional Centre has conducted meetings with Coordinators and other part time functionaries of Study Centre number of times during admission session to take the feedback, ideas and suggestions for promoting admission. In addition to regular meetings with LSCs special fortnight Meetings with the Coordinators were conducted for discussions on progress of providing online support services to prospective learners of IGNOU through different online medium
- j) Online Meetings with Academic Counsellors: The Regional Centre was in regular touch with the Academic Counsellors through Whatsapp Group, Emails and Online meetings to provide latest updates about new programmes, admission cycle and other also to take suggestion regarding online promotional activities. The Academic Counsellors were requested to disseminate the information about IGNOU Porgrammes and admission cycle among their academic circles and among prospective learners.
- k) **Extensive use of Social Media:** As on date Regional Centre Mumbai has its presence at social media Face book, Twitter and YouTube. The Face book page of Regional Centre has 8644 followers, twitter page has 1898 followers and YouTube has 3280 subscribers. Regional Centre Mumbai used these social media platforms extensively in order to disseminate the information for fresh admission among the general population and particularly to the existing learners.

Student support services (online/offline) in post admission to the learners:

1) **Online Induction Meeting:** The induction meetings for the freshly admitted learners could not be organized in face to face mode due to COVID 19 pandamic. In this critical situation the Regional Centre Mumbai has decided to conduct the

induction meeting through ICT platform. The meetings were organized in phased manner for different programmes on different dates. The learners were all informed through email and SMS to attend the online Induction meeting.

- 2) **Special Sessions for learners with Schools:** During the lockdown period the contact of the learners with study centres and the academic counsellors was slightly lost as all the institutions under lockdown as per the directions of Government of India. To facilitate the learners and have contact with academic counsellors ,the Regional Centre Mumbai has sent the contact details of all the academic counsellors programme wise/ course wise to all active learners. Further, the Regional Centre Mumbai has contacted the School faculty at IGNOU, New Delhi and organized special sessions for the programmes which are having project work/internship/high enrolment numbers
- 3) **Online Assignment Submission:** in order to make easy submission of scanned copies of handwritten assignments the Regional Centre, Mumbai has created Google forms and received assignments through Google Form.
- 4) **Online Synopsis Submission:** As assignments the project synopsis for MAPC, MCA, MAEDU, PGDEMA, and BCA programmes also received through Google forms.
- 5) **Online counselling sessions:** Due to Covid-19 pandemic counseling session for different programmes were conducted through online mode by using Google Meet, Zoom and Face book platform. Semester based programmes and high enrolled programs were given priority for conducting online counseling sessions. The concern study centre has prepared counseling schedule and send to the Regional Centre for approval. After getting the approval from the Regional Centre the counseling schedules have been uploaded on the Regional Centre Website, posted in Face book and informed to the students through email. There was a good response from the student from the students
- 6) **Webinars organized for the benefit of students:** The Regional Centre use to organize lectures/meetings/activities during important occasions to the learners, LSC staff and RC staff. With the same tendency the Regional Centre has organized good number of webinars on different topics during this period.
- 7) **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):** For the benefit of students during lockdown period, regional centre has prepared Frequently Asked Questions on admissions, induction, counselling, assignments, project, practical, term end exams and other important academic activities pertaining to the studies in IGNOU. The same has been

- uploaded in the Regional Centre website and the link was sent to the students through email/posted in social media for extensive usage and meet the purpose
- 8) **Online grievance redressal drive at Regional Centre:** Regional Centre Mumbai has initiated an online grievance redressal drive titled as "E-Shiksha Ki Baat, Regional Director KeSaath" (speak with your Regional Director) every Friday @ 11:00 am through google meet. The link has uploaded in RC Mumbai website and every Friday 50 students on average attend this drive.
- 9) **Grievance redressal drive at Study Centre:** As Regional Centre at LSC level also online/offline student grievance redressal drives also initiated in this year. The LSC will dedicate monthly one day exclusively conducting grievance redressal drive through online/offline. The details uploaded in our RC Mumbai website for the benefit of students
- 10) **Student queries through email:** in addition to online grievance meetings, student quarries also answered through email on an average 150-200 mails received in a day.
- 11) **Student queries through phone Call:** dedicated staff has been appointed to answer the phone calls at enquiry counter of RC. Presently two numbers are active such as 27489764 and 27455094 about 40-50 calls are answered in a day.
- 12)**Student grievance through letters:** though the usage of technology increased, students use to submit their queries through postal letter and all the queries will be solved time to time
- 13) **IGNOU Grievance Redress and Management (IGRAM):** Students use to submit their quarries through IGRAM, RC use to make every day ZERO queries by answering all the IGRAM queries on priority basis. On an average every day 35 grievances receiving by this RC Mumbai through IGRAM
- 14) MITRA A Telegram Room for support services: This year MITRA (Mumbai IGNOU Telegram Room for Assistance) a telegram channel has started by the Regional Centre as a part of strengthening student support services and providing better student support services.
- 15) **Posting important information in social media:** RC use to post all the important information, data, counselling schedules etc in to FB and twitter handle time to time. Recorded videos upload in the RC YouTube channel. It is pertinent to note that the

followers of RC Mumbai social media have increased remarkably during lockdown period. At present RC is having 9900 followers for Facebook, 2949 followers for twitter handle, 4890 subscribers for YouTube channel and 3562 subscribers for Telegram channel




After the practical session, Dr. Prashant Nitnaware, Coordinator, LSC 1632 gave the vote of thanks.






Dr. P Namboothiripad, Asst. Regional Director welcomed the resource persons and the learners for the session.



The admission procedure was also explained to the prospective learners by Regional Centre Officials.




