

## **GROWTH AND EXPANSION OF REGIONAL CENTRE MUMBAI (2009-2017)**

### HISTORY OF REGIONAL CENTRE:



IGNOU Regional Centre Mumbai was established with 18 LSC's in Jan. 2009, with the bifurcation of Pune region of Maharashtra. The purpose of a separate regional centre in Mumbai is to cater to the needs of konkan division of Maharashtra and to provide better student support services to the growing enrollment in konkan region. Two significant aspects of IGNOU regional centre are it includes greater Mumbai and Mumbai suburban where the population density is high. It covers around 25% of the total population of the state in a limited land area of 30865 sq.km.

Initially, the Regional center was housed in a rented building in Mulund East and later moved to a prominent and easily accessible location near to Mulund Railway station at Mulund west in Jan 2016.

The regional centre covers the konkan region of the state comprising districts of greater Mumbai, Mumbai Suburban, Thane, Palghar, Raigad and Ratnagiri. At present there are 26 learner support centers (LSC) with fresh admission of more than 10000 learners per year. There are 7 regular study centers, 14 programme study centers, 3 special study centers and 2 recognized study centres offering in total 80 academic programmes covering Masters, Bachelors, PG Diploma, Diploma, PG Certificate and Certificate levels. There are 560 academic counsellors providing academic support to the learners.

To further strengthen its root in this region, IGNOU Regional centre is pursuing with state government to have its own campus for which efforts are being taken to acquire land in Mumbai. The regional centre is also striving to establish collaborations not only with reputed educational institutions but also with other stake holders of higher education like corporates, NGO's, business organisations. Various efforts were taken in the past and present to strengthen IGNOU and distance education in the region.

Fresh student admission in the region is increased from around 4000 in 2009 to more than 10000 in 2016. At present RC Mumbai is having four Academics and 19 supporting staff. The number of LSCs, increased to 26 from 18 in 2009 The number of academic counselors rendering support to students increased from 78 in 2009 to the present strength of 560.

### **REGIONAL DIRECTORS**

Regional Director is overall head representing IGNOU, Delhi in the region. He / She is responsible for planning & implementing academic, administrative and financial activities in the region as per IGNOU policies and guidelines. He / She as an academic head is responsible for research and academic development at regional level. He/She is overall incharge / director for student support services / extension activities of regional centre and IGNOU study centres.



### DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE OF THE REGION


Mumbai is the capital of Maharashtra state and the name of the city is derived from goddess "Mumbadevi". Mumbai is also the financial, industrial & entertainment (Bollywood & Television Industry) capital of India.

The city houses important financial institutions like Reserve Bank of India, Bombay Stock Exchange, National Stock Exchange of India and it is also a head quarter of many Indian companies & Multinational corporations. It is a home to some of the India's premier scientific & nuclear institutes like BARC, NPCC, IRET, TIFR, AERB, AECI and the department of atomic energy

Mumbai is the most populous city of India and also world's fifth largest city by population. According to the 2011 census, the population of Mumbai city was 12,479,608. The population density is about 28,508 persons per square kilometer in Mumbai and Mumbai suburban regions. Greater Mumbai has a literacy rate of 94.7%, as against the national average of 74%. Thus, Mumbai has great potential for distance education as a highly populace city with high number of industries and corporations.




The sex ratio in 2011 was 838 females per 1,000 males in the island city, 857 in the suburbs, and 848 as a whole in Greater Mumbal, all numbers lower than the national average of 914. The low sex ratio is partly because of the large number of male migrants who come to the city to work. The high floating and working population of the region can take advantage of quality distance education through IGNOU.

The Mumbai regional centre of IGNOU covers six districts of Maharashtra comprising 24.7% of state population. Among the six districts of Regional Centre Mumbai, Mumbai suburban(20980), Mumbai(19652), and Thane(1157) are having the high population density as against the state average of 365.

### STUDENT SUPPORT & ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Academic activities of regional centre include student support activities (both administrative and academic matters), induction of students on Open University & its features, conduct of counseling (face to face sessions for students), multimedia learning inputs, orienting teachers to ODL system, establishing collaborations with stakeholders, research and academic development, skill training and regional development of ODL system.




